Welcome to the University of St. Thomas! We hope you enjoy your stay. Here are some of our conference services Frequently Asked Questions:

1. Where can I park on campus?

Parking is available free of charge during the summer months. Overnight parking is available in the Morrison Hall Ramp (Level 2); commuters to campus can park in surface lots A, B, C, K, M, N, O and the Anderson Parking Facility located on the corner of Grand and Cretin Avenues. You do not need a permit to park on campus during the summer.

2. Internet access---Wi-Fi info: Can I get wireless internet on campus?

Yes! There is no cost for this service and Wi-Fi can be accessed throughout our campus. Once you boot up your computer, you'll see our access page. Click the **Guest Icon** and then click "accept" to get on to the internet.

3. Do we have access to any fitness equipment?

Unfortunately, due to liability and the fact we charge memberships, the cardio, weight room and swimming pool is not available to summer guests. We encourage a run along historic Summit Avenue or a nice walk along Mississippi Boulevard which is just two blocks to the west. In addition, our outdoor track is available for running and walking. A sand volleyball court is available to the north of Ireland Hall.

4. This is a no smoking campus, I assume?

Smoking is permitted outside, only. No tobacco use is permitted in any building including the residence halls.

5. Is alcohol permitted on campus?

No alcoholic beverages can be served on campus without prior written consent. Alcoholic beverages for personal consumption, though, are permitted with-in your residence hall room. However, no alcoholic beverages can be consumed or openly transported in common areas including outdoors, meeting rooms, corridors, lounges, etc. Individuals possessing and/or consuming alcoholic beverages on UST's campus must be twenty-one (21) years of age or older.

6. Eating places in the area other than sites for our meals---do you have a listing?

T's Restaurant located in the Anderson Student Center is open Monday through Friday 7 AM – 6:00 PM; Saturday, 8 AM – 1:30 PM.

Summit Marketplace (a convenience store) also located in the Anderson Student Center is open Monday – Thursday 9 AM – 5 PM; Friday, 9 AM – 3PM.
