Sustainable urban environments







Activating The Exchange: Recent and Upcoming Milestones

The Programming Workstream has focused on crafting priorities, convening partners, identifying points of potential collaboration, and developing initial programming that will model the Exchange programs that are to come.



Activating The Exchange: Long-Term Outlook



May 2023: The Exchange networks, starts launching off-site programs, and commences design proceedings



2024-2025: More Phase 0 programs launch to support partner and community-based activities, enlivening The Exchange. This includes convening activities.



Summer 2028: Phase 1 construction of The Exchange is completed; The Exchange opens on Governors Island



Fall/Winter 2023: The Exchange ramps up hiring and programmatic activity to support Phase 0



~2.5 years postannouncement: The Exchange signs a ground lease with the Trust for Governors Island; construction begins



2028 and beyond:

The Exchange stabilizes operations on and off Governors Island, expediting critical climate solutions to market
