

Ian P. Rothwell Award in Inorganic Chemistry

The Ian P. Rothwell Award in Inorganic Chemistry will recognize graduate students in the inorganic division at Purdue University for their outstanding research accomplishments. The award will subsidize travel to a national chemistry conference (e.g. ACS, Gordon Conference) for the student to present their research in an oral or poster presentation. Each award will be \$500 and should be used to reimburse conference registration and travel costs. The award must be used within the following year, and inorganic students are eligible to receive this award once during their study at Purdue.

The application consists of a *cover page, research abstract, and CV*. Detailed information is provided below.

Cover Page:

1. Name
2. Email address
3. Research group
4. Year in Ph.D. program
5. Conference that you plan to attend including location and dates. Please indicate the type of presentation you are giving (oral or poster) and whether your abstract has already been accepted. If your abstract has not yet been accepted, provide a first and second choice of conference.
6. Confirmation that your advisor has approved your participation in the conference.

Research Abstract: 300 word maximum. You must include one figure.

CV: 2 page maximum.
